1 A serious further offence (SFO) is defined in Probation Circular 22 of 2008. Essentially it includes homicide or attempted homicide, rape or attempted rape and other serious violent or sexual offences with a maximum penalty of 14 years' imprisonment or more. Since 2008/9, the offence of wounding with intent to cause GBH (section 18 of the Offences Against the Person Act 1861) is no longer listed as a trigger offence and is not counted as an SFO for these purposes. NB These data relate only to those offenders who are charged with an SFO whilst managed at level 2 or 3 of MAPPA.
